- Developing programs aimed at promoting a preventive culture and self-care, encouraging healthy habits, well-being, and road safety strategies.
- Identifying, assessing, and controlling hazards, including those of road origin, to prevent work accidents, injuries, and/or occupational diseases.
- Establishing channels for participation and consultation on OHS and Road Safety issues for employees and their representatives.
- Ensuring compliance with legal requirements and established controls on Occupational Health and Safety and Road Safety for contractors and/or interested parties.

It is the responsibility of all employees, contractors, suppliers, and other interested parties to comply with the guidelines and standards for safe work and mobility. Additionally, it is their duty to promptly report any hazardous conditions that could lead to an incident, accident, or work-related illness.
